Building Demolition and Construction Commencement Confederation Line's Maintenance and Storage Facility

June 2013

Please note that demolition on Belfast Road (between 645 and 767 Belfast Rd.) is scheduled to begin the first week of July in preparation for construction of the Confederation Line's Maintenance and Storage Facility (MSF).



Impacts are expected to be minimal and demolition is scheduled to be completed in November 2013. Construction of the new Maintenance and Storage Facility (MSF) will begin late 2013/early 2014 and conclude in the summer of 2015. From 2016 to 2017 the facility will be used to assemble the Confederation Line's light rail vehicles. The facility will be in full operation in 2018.

The site totals 16-hectare and once constructed it will feature a 11,540m² state-of-the-art facility that will host the assembly, maintenance and operations of 34 new light rail Confederation Line vehicles. Vehicles will be transferred, cleaned, inspected and maintained at the facility. Approximately 150 jobs will be associated to the vehicle assembly and maintenance that will take place on this site.

Community Information Session

The City will host a community information session later this year (fall/winter) to provide details of the MSF's site plan, construction techniques and impacts.

A second information session is planned for early next year which will focus on the construction details of the MSF connector track, which will run parallel to Belfast Rd. connecting the future MSF to the system's mainline. Construction of the track is scheduled for the Spring of 2014 and work will be located within the City's right-of-way. Please be advised that community notices will be sent in advance of both information sessions.

We would also like to advise residents of upcoming night work along Highway 417. This work will include line painting and barrier installations over the next few weeks. As the project progresses we will continue to advise residents of scheduled night work adjacent to their community.
